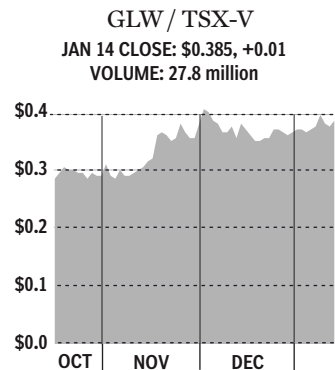

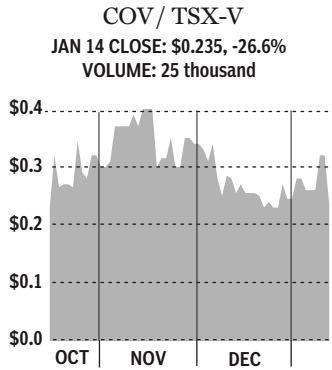

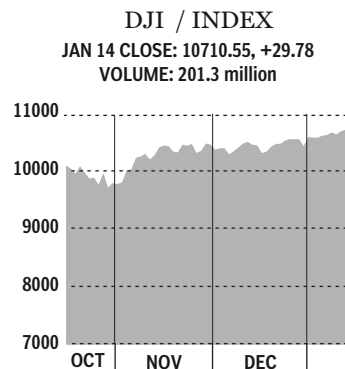

CF halts fertilizer takeover plans

TORONTO — Fertilizer giant CF Industries Holdings Inc. dropped its bid for Terra Industries Inc. Thursday but gave no indication that it is interested in merging with Canada's Agrium Inc.

Agrium then announced that it "remains fully committed" to buying CF and that it is nominating two directors

for election to CF's board.

Over the last 12 months, these three companies have engaged in a prolonged takeover war as they try and secure dominant positions in the nitrogen-fertilizer market in North America.

- to consider, pursuant to an order of the Court of Queen's Bench of Saskatchewan dated January 5, 2010 (the "Order"), and if deemed advisable, to approve, a plan of compromise and arrangement (the "Plan") under the CCAA and certain related matters; and
- to transact such further and other business as may properly be brought before the Creditors' Meeting or any adjournment thereof.

Pursuant to the Order, only Affected Creditors are entitled to vote with respect to the Plan.
