IN THE COURT OF QUEEN'S BENCH JUDICIAL CENTRE OF SASKATOON

IN THE MATTER OF THE COMPANIES' CREDITORS ARRANGEMENT ACT, R.S.C. 1985, c. C-36, AS AMENDED (the "CCAA")

AND IN THE MATTER OF A PROPOSED PLAN OF ARRANGEMENT FOR THE CREDITORS OF BIG SKY FARMS INC., DRY CAST SYSTEMS INC. and BIG SKY MANAGEMENT CONSULTING CORP. (collectively "Big Sky")

Take notice that Big Sky commenced proceedings under the CCAA on November 10, 2009 and was granted an *ex parte* order of the Court of Queen's Bench for Saskatchewan (the "Initial Order").

The Initial Order granted Big Sky various relief, including, *inter alia*, imposing a stay of proceedings against the creditors in respect to Big Sky and its assets, appointing Ernst & Young Inc. as Monitor, and providing Big Sky an opportunity to prepare and file a plan of arrangement or compromise for the consideration of its creditors and other stakeholders.

Pursuant to the Initial Order, Big Sky is to carry on business in a manner consistent with the commercially reasonable preservation of its respective business and assets.
