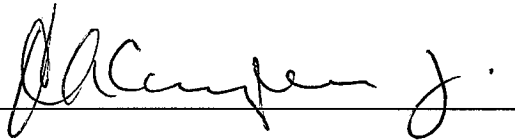
ORDER

**THIS MOTION**, made by Hollinger Canadian Publishing Holdings Co. (the "**Applicant**" or "**HCPH**"), for an Order relating to the transfer of certain pension assets was heard this day at 330 University Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

**UPON READING** the Notice of Motion dated October 12, 2010, the affidavit of Dennis M. Byrd sworn October 12, 2010, the Fourth Report of the Monitor dated October 13, 2010 (the "**Monitor's Fourth Report**") and upon hearing the submissions of counsel for the Applicant, the Monitor and Representative Counsel,

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that, subject to the consent by the Superintendent of Financial Services of Ontario for and following the transfer of assets from the pension fund

of the Hollinger Canadian Publishing Holdings Co. Pension Plan for the Employees of Newspapers Formerly Owned by Thomson Newspapers, Registration No. 1033786 (the "**Thomson Plan**") to the CanWest Pension Plan for Vancouver Island Employees, B.C. Registration No. 086435, representing the value of defined contribution account balances of certain former members of the Thomson Plan whose employment was transferred to CanWest Global Communications Corporation, effective January 1, 2001 (the "**CanWest Employee Account Balances**"), Postmedia Networks Inc. shall have no liability for any claims liabilities, damages, awards, orders, judgments, actions, prosecutions or proceedings by whosoever made, brought or prosecuted, in respect of the administration or investment of the CanWest Employee Balances in respect of the period prior to such transfer.
