**NOTICE OF THE CLAIMS PROCEDURE FOR WHITE BIRCH PAPER
HOLDING COMPANY AND VARIOUS SUBSIDIARIES AND
AFFILIATES, ("WHITE BIRCH") PURSUANT TO THE COMPANIES'
CREDITORS ARRANGEMENT ACT ("CAA")**

The Court number assigned to these proceedings is 500-11-038474-108. The entities affected by the Initial Order rendered on February 24, 2010 are White Birch Paper Holding Company, White Birch Paper Company, Stadacona General Partner Inc., Black Spruce Paper Inc., F.F. Soucy General Partner Inc., 3120772 Nova Scotia Company, Arrimage De Gros Cacouna Inc., Papier Masson Ltée., Stadacona Limited Partnership, F.F. Soucy Limited Partnership, and F.F. Soucy, Inc. & Partners, Limited Partnership.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on May 6th, 2010 the Quebec Superior Court (Commercial Division), District of Montréal issued an order establishing a claims procedure for the identification, resolution and barring of claims against White Birch (the "**Claims Procedure Order**") and ordered that Ernst & Young Inc., in its capacity as Court-appointed Monitor of White Birch, send proof of claim forms to each known creditor of White Birch. Any person who believes that it has a claim against White Birch, other than an Excluded Claim (as defined in the Claims Procedure Order), which arose prior to February 24, 2010, must submit a proof of claim to the Monitor to be received at the latest by 5:00 p.m. (Montréal Time) on June 21, 2010 (the "**Claims Bar Date**"), failing which the person will be forever barred from advancing a claim against White Birch or from receiving any distribution under any plan of arrangement of White Birch (the "**Plan**") on account of such claim.

Any person who believes that it has a claim which arose on or after February 24, 2010 as a result of receiving a written notice for the repudiation, termination or restructuring of any contract, lease, employment agreement or other agreement (a "**Restructuring Claim**") must submit a proof of claim to the Monitor by the later of the Claims Bar Date or no later than 5:00 p.m. (Montréal Time) on the 30th day following the receipt of a written notice advising such person to file a proof of claim as a result of the repudiation, termination or restructuring of any contract, lease, employment agreement or other agreement on or after February 24, 2010, failing which such person will be forever barred from advancing a Restructuring Claim against White Birch and from receiving a distribution under the Plan on account of such claim.

**CLAIMS AND RESTRUCTURING CLAIMS WHICH ARE NOT RECEIVED
BY THE MONITOR AS DIRECTED HEREIN ABOVE SHALL BE
FOREVER BARRED.**

Claims packages and proofs of claim forms will be mailed to all known creditors by May 21, 2010. Creditors who do not receive a claim package from the Monitor may contact the Monitor at: Ernst & Young Inc., Court-appointed Monitor of White Birch *et al.* (**Telephone: 1-877-694-3422, Fax: (514) 879-3991, or website www.ey.com/ca/WhiteBirch**) to obtain a claim package.

Some of the entities affected by the Initial Order have requested and obtained relief under Chapter 15 of the U.S. *Bankruptcy Code*. There will not be a separate claims process for U.S. creditors of the entities affected by the Initial Order. The Claims Procedure Order is in the process of being recognized under Chapter 15 of the U.S. *Bankruptcy Code* and thereafter all U.S. creditors shall be bound by the Claims Procedure Order.
