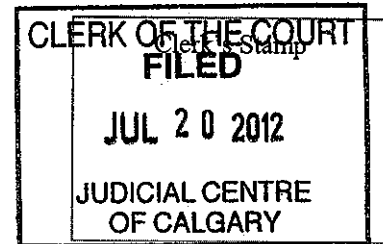

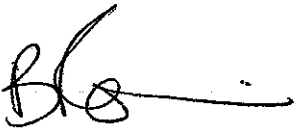
**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

**Service**

1. The time for service of this notice of this Application for this Order is hereby abridged and deemed good and sufficient and this Application is properly returnable today.

**Extension of Claims Bar Date**

2. The Claims Bar Date of August 2, 2012 established by the Claims Procedure Order pronounced by this Court on June 28, 2012 (the "Claims Procedure Order") is hereby extended to August 31, 2012.
3. The Monitor shall arrange to publish a Notice to Creditors advertisement in the Calgary Herald informing creditors of the extension of the Claims Bar Date.
4. The Monitor shall arrange to publish in the Wall Street Journal a Notice to US Creditors advertisement substantially in the form of Notice to Creditors Advertisement attached hereto as Schedule "A1".
5. The Monitor shall serve a copy of this Order on all parties attending the hearing of the within application, and the Monitor shall post a copy of this Order on its website, which together shall be deemed good and sufficient service of this Order upon all interested parties.
6. The Monitor is at liberty and is hereby authorized and empowered to apply to any Court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body, where ever located, for the recognition of this Order and for advice, assistance and direction as may be necessary to give full force and effect to, and in carrying out the terms of this Order.

**SCHEDULE "A1"**

**NOTICE TO THE CREDITORS OF OILSANDS QUEST INC., OILSANDS QUEST SASK INC., TOWNSHIP PETROLEUM CORPORATION AND 1291329 ALBERTA LTD.**

On November 29, 2011, Oilsands Quest Inc. Oilsands Quest Sask Inc., Township Petroleum Corporation and 1291329 Alberta Ltd. (collectively the "Companies"), applied for and received protection from its creditors by order of the Court of Queen's Bench of Alberta (the "Court") pursuant to the Companies Creditors' Arrangements Act (the "CCAA"). Ernst & Young Inc. was appointed Monitor of the Companies (the "Monitor").

On June 28, 2012, the Court granted a further order prescribing a process by which the identity and status of all creditors of the Companies and the amounts of their claims will be established for purposes of the CCAA proceedings (the "Claims Process Order"). On July 20, 2012, the Court granted a further order extending the claims bar date to August 31, 2012 (the "US Claims Process Order").

Pursuant to the Claims Process Order and US Claims Process Order, the Monitor, in cooperation with the Companies, is to send a notice to each known creditor of the Companies (the "Notice to Creditor") indicating the amount of such creditor's claim as of November 29, 2011. In the case of the claims of creditors whose claims are disputed, a Notice to Creditor will be sent containing the amount which the Companies is prepared to allow as a claim by such creditor.

**CREDITORS RECEIVING A NOTICE TO CREDITOR WHO AGREE WITH THE AMOUNT SHOWN AS OWED TO THEM BY THE COMPANIES IN THE NOTICE TO CREDITOR NEED TAKE NO FURTHER STEPS TO PROVE OR PRESERVE THEIR CLAIMS.**

**ANY CREDITOR HAVING A CLAIM AGAINST THE COMPANIES WHO HAS NOT RECEIVED A NOTICE TO CREDITOR OR WHO DISAGREES WITH THE AMOUNT OR STATUS OF THE CLAIM AS INDICATED IN THE NOTICE TO CREDITOR MUST FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM WITH THE MONITOR IN THE PRESCRIBED FORM BEFORE AUGUST 31, 2012 IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY VOTING OR DISTRIBUTIONS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CCAA PROCEEDINGS. CLAIMS NOT PROVEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THESE PROCEDURES SHALL, UNLESS OTHERWISE ORDERED BY THE COURT, BE DEEMED TO BE FOREVER BARRED AND MAY NOT BE ADVANCED AGAINST THE COMPANIES.**

Any creditor who chooses to file a Proof of Claim is required to provide whatever supporting documentation they may have, such as contracts, bonds, investment forms, cancelled cheques, bills of sale, receipts, or invoices in support of their claim, as at November 29, 2011.

All claims must be made in the prescribed "Proof of Claim" form together with the required supporting documentation and be postmarked or received the Monitor on or before the Claims Bar Date, being August 31, 2012.
