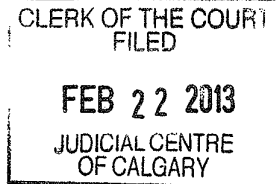

Remedy claimed or sought:

1. An order directing Ernst & Young Inc., in its capacity as the Monitor of the Applicants, Oilsands Quest Sask Inc., 1291329 Alberta Ltd. and Township Petroleum Corporation, to serve the Distribution and Discharge: Receivership Order dated January 30, 2013 (the “Distribution Order”) and the Receiver’s First Report dated January 22, 2013 on all of the creditors of Oilsands Quest Sask Inc. (the “Sask Creditors”);
2. An order granting the Sask Creditors the right to make application to this court, within 10 days from the date of service of the Distribution Order on them, for the Distribution Order to be varied. Any such application to be served on the Monitor’s legal counsel, Borden Ladner Gervais LLP, 1900, 520-3 Avenue SW, Calgary, AB T2P 0R3, Attention: Josef G.A. Krüger, Q.C.: jkruger@blg.com.

Grounds for making this application:

3. The above relief is needed to provide a remedy to the Sask Creditors in connection with the Distribution Order because the application pursuant to which the Distribution Order was made was not served on them.
