Dear Jennifer/Theresa,

I have reviewed the indemnification agreement and do not believe that it is reasonable for Mr. Milne and Mr. Thompson to retain separate counsel.

At this time, Mr. Milne and Mr. Thompson are welcome to retain counsel of their choice at their own expense, but the Company will not indemnify them as we have retained experienced New York counsel to represent all of the Oilsands defendants. I believe that it is in everyone's interest for them to be represented by the same counsel as the rest of the defendants.

Please pass along my comments along to Mr. Milne and Mr. Thompson and ask that either they respond directly to me or to you on their behalf with how they intend to proceed. Please also note that if Mr. Thompson has been served, his time to respond to the complaint is limited and he should decide how to proceed as soon as possible.
