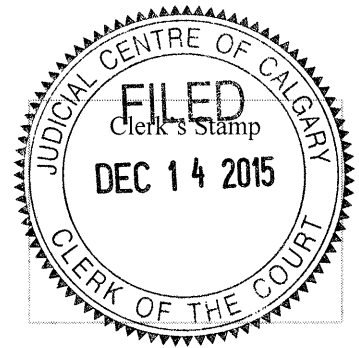

UPON the Application of Foundation Mortgage Corporation and Foundation Mortgage "2" Corporation (together the "Company"); AND UPON having read the Affidavit of Gary L.
