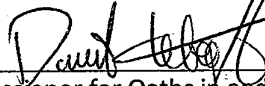

Dear Fellow Investors:

The Unsecured Creditors' Committee ("UCC") is hosting a series of Information sessions in an effort to share pertinent information about their investments and the current CCAA proceedings in the court.

We became concerned when we read the affidavit of Ron Aitkens that was filed on the Monitor's website on December 21st, 2011. This was done because Harvest Group (formerly known as Foundation Capital Corp) was not able to meet the cash requirements needed to pay out the bonds on Airdrie and Legacy that matured December 31, 2011.

Our greatest concerns from the information revealed in Ron Aitkens affidavit were as follows:

1. The lands in Elbow Valley, The Legacy project were not owned yet by the investors and the creditors to date only had title on 100 acres of an expected 503 acre parcel.
2. Investors were entitled to purchase the remaining 400 acres for a price of \$9 Million dollars; however the balance sheet only showed \$8542.83 in the bank. This is not enough to exercise the option and finish paying for the rest of the land.
3. The Affidavit shows that over \$9.5 Million was taken out of the Legacy project and invested or loaned as follows:
 - a. \$4.924 Million Invested in a resort development on the island of Panama.
 - b. \$2.723 Million was invested in a solar power venture in a property in Balsam Lake Ontario, again, we have not received confirmation that we are on title on this land.
 - c. \$1.350 Million and \$590K were invested in a Shopping Centre called Liberty Crossing in Red Deer.

There seems to be little support in the Offering Memorandum to remove funds for these purposes.

4. Lastly, In the Airdrie investment it had also come to our attention that a Sour Gas well exists on that land that could make development more expensive and/ or very difficult. We confirmed that it had not been disclosed in the Offering Memorandum that this Sour Gas Well existed nor did any of the profit / development projections include the removal of a well of this nature.

The UCC has requested a variety of information from the Monitor. The Monitor has indicated that it will have a "Sources and Uses" study done in time for our presentations. This study should shed further light on where Legacy and Airdrie funds have been spent, and also assist all creditors in determining what restructuring alternatives exist to maximize the recovery of their investments.

Ownership Structure



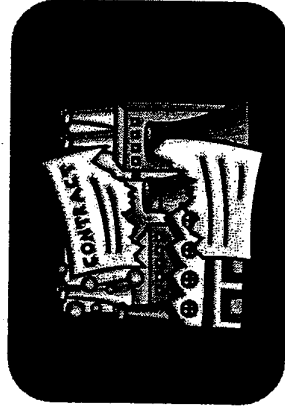
