

NOTICE OF MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a meeting of Creditors of Foundation Place Capital Inc. holding Eligible Voting Claims will be held at Centennial Place, 3rd Floor of West Tower, 250 – 5th Street S.W., Calgary, Alberta at 9:30 a.m. on May 6, 2014 (Calgary time) for the following purposes:

1. to consider, pursuant to an order of the Alberta Court of Queen's Bench dated April 14, 2014 (the "**Creditors' Meeting Order**"), and if deemed advisable, to approve a plan of compromise and arrangement (the "**CCAA Plan**") under the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act* (Canada); and
2. to transact such further and other business as may be properly brought before the Creditors' Meeting or any adjournment thereof.

Pursuant to the Creditors' Meeting Order only Creditors of Foundation Place Capital Inc. who hold Eligible Voting Claims are entitled to vote on the CCAA Plan.

Creditors who are unable to attend the Creditors' Meeting are requested to date, sign and return the accompanying form of proxy in the envelope provided for that purpose.
