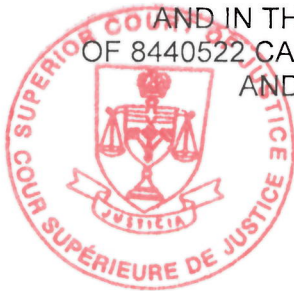

**ORDER
