The Court of Queen's Bench Act

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Sealing confidential documents

77(1) The court may order that a document filed in a civil proceeding is confidential, is to be sealed and is not a part of the public record of the proceeding.

Documents public

77(2) Upon payment of the prescribed fee, if any, a person may see

(a) a list of the proceedings in the court, or

(b) a document that is filed in a proceeding,

unless otherwise provided by statute, by the rules or by an order.

Copies

77(3) Upon payment of the prescribed fee, if any, a person shall receive a copy of a document filed in a proceeding that is available for public inspection under subsection (2).
