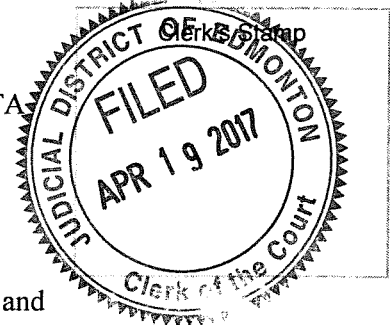

UPON THE APPLICATION of the Receiver, Ernst & Young Inc.; AND UPON HAVING READ the Receiver's 5th Report dated April 11, 2017, filed; AND UPON hearing representations from counsel for the Receiver and Counsel for Farm Credit Canada ("FCC") and Counsel for Agriculture Financial Services Corporation ("AFSC") and upon being advised that Counsel for Providence Grain Group Inc. ("PGG") is not appearing at this application but has reviewed and is in support of the relief sought in this Order; AND UPON being advised that on August 25, 2016 PGG filed an application in the within action seeking a declaration that it was the sole owner of all right, title and interest of the below described Dryer, which application was supported by a filed Affidavit of Milton Miller (the "PGG Application"); AND UPON being advised that PGG claims ownership to the below described Dryer which ownership is not opposed by either FCC or AFSC; AND UPON being advised that given the position of AFSC and FCC and upon it appearing the below described Dryer was paid for by PGG, the Receiver seeks to abandon any claim it potentially could have against the below described Dryer; IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to abandon any potential interest in the 40' direct heat horizontal rotary grain dryer system and all associated components (collectively the "Dryer"), which the Receiver, Growing Power Management Ltd. or Growing Power Hairy Hill Limited Partnership may have had or have, if any, which Dryer is the subject of a property claim by Providence Grain Group Inc.

2. The Preservation Order of Justice D.A. Sulyma dated September 16, 2016 regarding the Dryer is hereby set aside.
3. The PGG application is hereby withdrawn on a without costs basis.
4. There shall be no costs to any party in relation to issues or steps taken regarding the Dryer, or arising from the Preservation Order.
