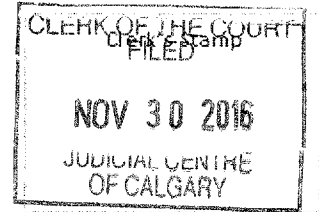

INTRODUCTION

1. Ernst & Young Inc. was appointed as Receiver (the "Receiver") of the property, assets and undertakings (the "Property") of Spyglass Resources Corp., 1196823 Alberta Ltd., 1288916 Alberta Ltd., 1398850 Alberta Ltd., 1583662 Alberta Ltd., 1636527 Alberta Ltd., AvenEx Energy Partnership, AvenEx Real Estate Acquisition Corp., Westbrook Marketing Limited Partnership (formerly Elbow River Marketing Limited Partnership), 1159002 Alberta Ltd. (formerly Elbow River Marketing Corp.), Meota 2000 Partnership, Pace Oil & Gas Partnership, Pace Oil Resources Ltd. and Seaview Energy Partnership (collectively, "Spyglass", the "Company" or the "Debtor") pursuant to an Order of this Honourable Court (the "Receivership Order") dated November 26, 2015 (the "Appointment Date").
2. The Receivership Order authorized the Receiver, among other things, to carry on the business of Spyglass, to sell, convey, transfer, lease or assign the Property out of the normal course of business, subject to approval of this Honourable Court for any transactions exceeding \$1.0 million, or the aggregate of multiple transactions exceeding \$5.0 million, and to make such arrangements or agreements as deemed necessary by the Receiver.
3. The purpose of this seventh report (the "Seventh Report") of the Receiver is to provide this Honourable Court with the Receiver's comments on:
 - a) The details of the completed lien claims process; and
 - b) The Receiver's request for advice and directions to:
 - i. Approve the Lien Settlements (as defined and further detailed below); and
 - ii. Set aside certain Notice of Disputes of the Disputed Claimants (each as defined and further detailed below).

TERMS OF REFERENCE

4. Capitalized terms not defined in this Seventh Report are as defined in the Receivership Order or Liens Claims Process Order (defined below).
5. All references to dollars are in Canadian currency unless otherwise noted.

BACKGROUND

6. Prior to the Receivership Order, Spyglass was engaged in the acquisition, enhancement and exploration of conventional oil and gas projects in Alberta and British Columbia. As of the granting of the Receivership Order, Spyglass had a licensed interest in approximately 2,500 producing oil wells in Alberta and participating interest in over 4,500 wells. Spyglass was the operator of its core facilities. The Debtors' operations produced approximately 9,300 barrels of oil equivalent per day in Q3 2015. The particulars of Spyglass' operations are set out at paragraphs 11 to 22 of the Receiver's First Report, dated January 20, 2016.
7. Prior to the granting of the Receivership Order, Spyglass was experiencing financial difficulties due primarily to the extended depressed market prices for oil and gas. Spyglass attempted to alleviate its financial difficulties by engaging in a broad disposition process for core and non-core assets. Due to insufficient liquidity, Spyglass was unable to continue this disposition process and unable to close a transaction, prompting its primary secured lender, the Syndicate, to successfully petition Spyglass into receivership.

EXECUTION OF THE LIEN CLAIMS PROCESS

Claims process

8. In order to ensure that the Receiver had received all lien claims that had been registered against the Debtors' mineral interests, the Receiver sought and obtained a Court Order from this Honourable Court, dated July 6, 2016, establishing a lien claims process (the "Lien Claims Process Order"). The Lien Claims Process Order established a liens claim bar date of August 22, 2016 (the "Claims Bar Date"). The Claims Bar Date was calculated as being the date which was 90 days from November 25, 2015 (the limitation period for registering a lien against oil and gas properties pursuant to the *Builders' Lien Act* (Alberta) (the "BLA")), plus an additional 180 days (the limitation period for commencing a statement of claim and filing certificate of *lis pendens* ("CLP") pursuant to the BLA). As such, the Claims Bar Date incorporated the substantive lien rights pursuant to the BLA and only abrogated the procedural service provisions of the *Alberta Rules of Court* and the *British Columbia Supreme Court Civil Rules*.
9. In accordance with the Lien Claims Process Order, the Receiver notified potential lien claimants of the Claims Bar Date by:

- a) Placing advertisements in the *Globe and Mail*, the *Calgary Herald* and the *Daily Oil Bulletin* on July 13, 2016 and again on July 20, 2016;
 - b) Sending a notice to all of the Debtors' known creditors on July 19, 2016; and
 - c) Placing a copy of the notice on the Receiver's website established in respect of these proceedings on July 6, 2016.
10. Establishing the Lien Claims Process was the most efficient and cost-effective mechanism to ensure that all lien claims were accounted for and proper distributions made.

Claims resolution

11. All lien claimants, whether known or unknown, were required to deliver to the Receiver, in accordance with the timelines under the Lien Claims Process Order and as set-out in the Fifth Report, a Proof of Claim Form and an Affidavit of Truth of Proof of Claim Form, which operated as the lien claimants' Affidavit to Prove Lien in accordance with section 48 of the *Alberta Builder's Lien Act* and similar to the information contained in an action to enforce a claim of lien pursuant to section 33 of the *BC Builder's Lien Act*.
12. Any person who claimed to have a lien claim was to prepare a Proof of Claim Form and an Affidavit of Truth of Proof of Claim Form and was to serve it on the Receiver on or before 5:00 p.m. Calgary time, on the Claims Bar Date.
13. Any lien claim not submitted in accordance with this procedure by the Claims Bar Date or otherwise allowed by the claims process, was forever barred, released and extinguished pursuant to the Lien Claims Process Order.
14. A total of 113 companies submitted a Proof of Claim Form on or before the Claims Bar Date.
15. After the Claims Bar Date, the Receiver held a meeting with the Receiver's counsel, Borden Ladner Gervais LLP ("BLG") to review the claims.
16. The 113 Proof of Claim Forms submitted consisted of the following:
- a) 91 claimants who had not registered a lien right and simply have an unsecured claim, subordinate to the Syndicate, Spyglass' first secured creditor ("Unsecured Claimants");

- b) 12 claimants who had not registered a lien right; however these claims were submitted by Spyglass' JV partners for balances owing before and, in certain cases after, the Appointment Date ("JV Claimants"). The payment of the post-receivership payables is being addressed outside of the Lien Claims Process between the Receiver, the purchaser of the Debtors' assets, SanLing Energy Ltd. ("SanLing"), and the JV partners;
 - c) Eight claimants who submitted claims with a registered lien right ("Registered Lien Claimants"); and
 - d) Two claimants who had not registered a lien right; however submitted claims for annual surface or mineral lease payments, which have since been clarified and settled by the Receiver.
17. The total amount of the claims submitted was \$2,427,107. Of this amount, \$1,418,135 related to Unsecured Claimants, \$479,258 related to JV Claimants and \$526,347 related to Registered Lien Claimants.

18. The Receiver had the ability to question lien claimants who submitted a Proof of Claim Form to it by way of oral examinations or written interrogatories, as arranged between the Receiver and the subject lien claimant. Any lien claimant who received a list of written interrogatories from the Receiver had five business days to reply to the Receiver and furnish the Receiver with any requested documentation. Through its counsel, BLG, the Receiver sent a request for written interrogatories to three of the Registered Lien Claimants, requesting further information concerning their respective lien claims. The Receiver received responses from two of the three Registered Lien Claimants to its request for written interrogatories.

19. The Receiver had until September 22, 2016, or such later date as may have been reasonably required by the Receiver, to review the Proof of Claim Forms and the Receiver had the ability to allow or disallow all or any portion of a lien claim, and communicate any disallowance of a lien claim to the lien claimant (a "Notice of Revision or Disallowance"). The Receiver mailed the Notice of Revision or Disallowance to all claimants who submitted Proof of Claim Forms on September 22, 2016 by registered mail. The Notice of Revision or Disallowance was final, binding and conclusive, unless disputed in accordance with the Lien Claims Process Order as more fully discussed below.
20. Any lien claimant had ten business days from the date of receipt of a Notice of Revision or Disallowance (the "Dispute Period") to file and serve on BLG, a Notice of Dispute of the Notice of Revision or Disallowance (a "Notice of Dispute"). All claims which were not disputed within the Dispute Period were deemed to be accepted as final and binding.
21. BLG received the following ten Notice of Disputes of which, five were from Unsecured Claimants, one was from a JV Claimant, one was from a claimant with an unregistered lien claim (the "Unregistered Lien Claimant"), and three were from Registered Lien Claimants.

22. In consultation with its counsel, BLG, and after considering the merits of the respective Notice of Disputes and the costs associated with litigating such disputes, the Receiver negotiated settlements with the Registered Lien Claimants that submitted Notice of Disputes. In particular, the Receiver has entered into and carried out the terms of the following lien claim settlements:

- a) Reference # SGL0105: Bidell Equipment Limited Partnership ("Bidell") submitted a Proof of Claim Form in the amount of \$286,655.93. The Receiver issued a Notice of Revision or Disallowance to Bidell, revising its claim to \$12,786.22, on the basis that certain amounts claimed were unalienable costs including, but not limited to, travel labour, mileage and consumables. Additionally, certain liens submitted by Bidell were subordinate to the first secured indebtedness and since the Receivership generated insufficient proceeds to fully repay the first secured indebtedness, payment of subordinate claims was not possible. Bidell submitted a Notice of Dispute to the Receiver seeking \$286,779.90. The Receiver settled Bidell's Notice of Dispute for \$50,000.

- b) Reference # SGL0111: Strike Energy Services Inc. ("Strike") submitted a Proof of Claim Form in the amount of \$84,033.41. The Receiver issued a Notice of Revision or Disallowance to Strike, revising its claim to \$24,560.95, on the basis that certain amounts claimed were unalienable costs including, but not limited to, travel and groceries/sustenance. Additionally, certain liens submitted by Strike were subordinate to the first secured indebtedness and since the Receivership generated insufficient proceeds to fully repay the first secured indebtedness, payment of subordinate claims was not possible. Strike submitted a Notice of Dispute to the Receiver seeking \$119,168.71. The Receiver settled Strike's Notice of Dispute for \$36,560.95.
 - c) Reference # SGL0110: Rapid Rod Services Ltd. ("Rapid Rod") submitted a Proof of Claim Form in the amount of \$103,455.00. The Receiver issued a Notice of Revision or Disallowance to Rapid Rod, revising its claim to \$57,150.05, on the basis that certain amounts claimed were unalienable costs. Additionally, Rapid Rod did not register a *certificate of lis pendens* in respect of certain liens and certain liens submitted by Rapid Rod were subordinate to the first secured indebtedness and since the Receivership generated insufficient proceeds to fully repay the first secured indebtedness, payment of subordinate claims was not possible. Rapid Rod submitted a Notice of Dispute to the Receiver seeking \$86,805.00. The Receiver settled Rapid Rod's Notice of Dispute for \$77,010.05.
23. The Receiver settled these claims for a total of \$166,571 (the "Lien Settlements"). Each of Bidell, Strike and Rapid Rod have filed discontinuances of their respective statement of claims pertaining to the liens, as well as discharges of the liens and certificates of *lis pendens* with the Land Titles Office or the Department of Energy, where applicable. As a result, the Receiver's trust conditions pertaining to these settlements have been fulfilled and the Lien Settlements have been released to each of Bidell, Strike and Rapid Rod.
24. In addition, the Receiver revised the claims submitted by two Registered Lien Claimants to \$4,503 (the "Revised Payments"). The Receiver did not receive Notice of Disputes from these parties. In particular, the Receiver has revised these claims as follows:
- a) Reference # SGL0107: JaCar Energy Services, a division of Cascade Energy Services LP ("JaCar") submitted a Proof of Claim Form in the amount of \$1,753.50.

The Receiver issued a Notice of Revision or Disallowance to JaCar revising its claim to \$1,624.07, on the basis that \$129.43 had already been paid by Spyglass.

- b) Reference # SGL0109: Precision Rentals ("Precision") submitted a Proof of Claim Form in the amount of \$2,878.45 plus interest. The Receiver issued a Notice of Revision or Disallowance to Precision revising its claim to \$2,878.45, on the basis that no contract was provided that demonstrated the ability to claim interest.
- 25. The Receiver has delivered the Revised Payments to each of JaCar and Precision, respectively, on the trust condition that the funds are not releasable until the Receiver has received copies of the discharges of lien statements and discontinuances of statements of claim. As of the date of filing this Report, JaCar had satisfied the Receiver's trust conditions and the Receiver had yet to receive a reply from Precision.
 - 26. The total accepted claims pursuant to the lien claims process was \$171,074, which includes the Lien Settlements and Revised Payments.
 - 27. The Notice of Dispute received from the JV Claimant, Crescent Point Energy Corp., in regards to Reference # SGL0097 for \$35,230 was withdrawn.
 - 28. Additionally, two of the Unsecured Claimants also withdrew their respective Notice of Disputes, in the aggregate amount of \$96,411. These withdrawals pertained to T.T.'s Transportation Ltd. and Eldon's Transportation Ltd. in regards to Reference #SGL0078 for \$2,046.45 and Reference #SGL0026 for \$94,364.63, respectively.
 - 29. The three remaining Unsecured Claimants and the Unregistered Lien Claimant (the "Disputed Claimants") have not withdrawn their claims.
 - 30. The three remaining Unsecured Claimants are:
 - a) Ambush Enterprises Ltd. in regards to Reference #SGL00007 for \$10,669.07 ("Ambush Claim");
 - b) Vic's Ventures Ltd. in regards to Reference #SGL0086 for \$5,428.50 ("Vic Claim"); and
 - c) Greg's Water Hauling in regards to Reference #SGL0039 for \$435.00 ("Water Claim").

Attached hereto and marked collectively as Appendix "A" are copies of the Proof of Claim Form, Notice of Disallowance and Notice of Dispute regarding the Ambush Claim. Attached hereto and marked collectively as Appendix "B" are copies of the Proof of Claim Form, Notice of Disallowance and Notice of Dispute regarding the Vic Claim. Attached hereto and marked collectively as Appendix "C" are copies of the Proof of Claim Form, Notice of Disallowance and Notice of Dispute regarding the Water Claim.

31. The Receiver is of the view that these are not lien claimants. Each simply has an unsecured claim, subordinate to the Syndicate, Spyglass' first secured creditor. As there were insufficient proceeds from the receivership to fully repay the Syndicate, there will not be any distributions to unsecured creditors. The Receiver has communicated this position to each of the three remaining Unsecured Claimants and requested that they withdraw their respective Notice of Disputes in light of this. The Receiver has not received a reply to its correspondence from the three remaining Unsecured Claimants. Attached hereto and marked collectively as Appendix "D" are copies of the requests sent by the Receiver to the three remaining Unsecured Claimants to withdraw their Notice of Disputes.
32. As a result, the Receiver requests this Honourable Court's assistance in setting aside the Notice of Disputes submitted by the Unsecured Claimants and confirming that the Receiver shall have no obligation to remit any payment to them pursuant to the Lien Claims Process.
33. The Unregistered Lien Claimant is Ronwood Enterprises Ltd. ("Ronwood"), whose Notice of Dispute pertains to Reference #SGL0069 for \$45,368.06. Attached hereto and marked collectively as Appendix "E" are copies of the Proof of Claim Form, Notice of Disallowance and Notice of Dispute regarding Ronwood's claim.
34. Ronwood asserts that it has a lien claim against Spyglass as a result of a prevenient arrangement with Spyglass. Ronwood asserts that it has continued to provide lienable services for Spyglass, and as such, its limitation within which to file a lien has not yet begun to run.
35. Ronwood has not provided services for Spyglass since, at the very latest, June 15, 2016, the closing date of the sale of Spyglass' assets to SanLing. Any subsequent services provided by Ronwood were provided to SanLing. The last invoice Ronwood delivered to the Receiver respecting Spyglass was dated June 14, 2016. Ronwood began invoicing SanLing for services Ronwood provided to SanLing on or about July 6, 2016.

36. Ronwood submitted a claim in Spyglass' lien claims process without a registered lien. Its claim was disallowed by the Receiver as a result of the fact that it needed to have a registered interest in order to have priority over the Syndicate. The BLA requires lien claimants to register a lien claim against oil and gas assets within 90 days' of the last date of work provided. Therefore, Ronwood had until September 15, 2016 to register a lien claim against Spyglass and they have failed to do so. Attached hereto and marked together as Appendix "F" is a copy of Ronwood's last invoice to the Receiver and its invoice to SanLing dated July 6, 2016.
37. The Receiver has communicated its position to Ronwood that Ronwood is out of time to register a lien claim and requested that it withdraw its Notice of Dispute in light of this. The Receiver has not received a reply to its correspondence from Ronwood. Attached hereto and marked as Appendix "G" is a copy of the request sent by the Receiver to Ronwood to withdraw its Notice of Dispute.
38. As a result, the Receiver requests this Honourable Court's assistance in setting aside the Notice of Dispute submitted by the Unregistered Lien Claimant, Ronwood, and confirming that the Receiver shall have no obligation to remit any payment to it.
39. Subject to this Honourable Court's findings with respect to the Receiver's request for advice and directions respecting the treatment of the Disputed Claimants' Notice of Disputes, the Receiver also seeks a direction from this Honourable Court that the Lien Claims Process is now complete.

REQUESTED RELIEF

40. The Receiver respectfully requests this Honourable Court's advice and directions with respect to:
- a) Approval of the Lien Settlements;
 - b) Setting aside the notice of disputes of the Disputed Claimants and confirming that the Receiver shall have no obligation to remit any payment to the Disputed Claimants; and
 - c) Declaring the Lien Claims Process complete.

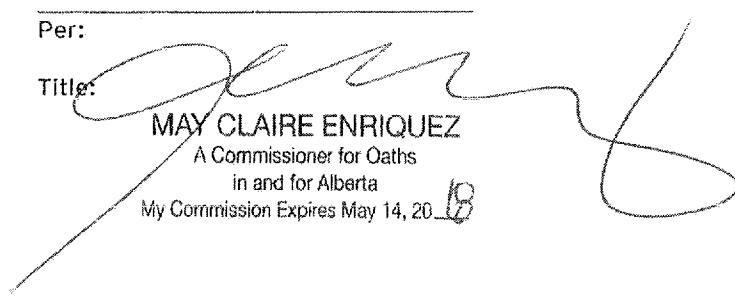

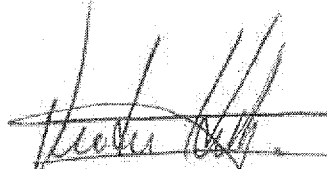

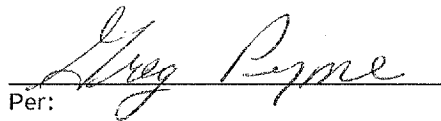

We are counsel to Ernst & Young Inc., in its capacity as the court-appointed receiver of Spyglass and certain of its related affiliates and subsidiaries (the "**Receiver**"). We write with respect to the lien claims process respecting Spyglass, and in particular, the Notice of Dispute delivered by Ambush Enterprises Ltd. ("**Ambush**") to the Receiver.

We have reviewed and considered Ambush's Notice of Dispute and the reasons for the dispute stated therein. In our view, there is no legal merit to Ambush's dispute in the circumstances. Further to our letter dated October 12, 2016, we have now had the opportunity to review and consider the Notice of Dispute delivered by Ronwood Enterprises Ltd. ("**Ronwood**") to us, as counsel for Ernst & Young Inc., in its capacity as the court-appointed receiver of Spyglass and certain of its related affiliates and subsidiaries (the "**Receiver**"). In the Notice of Dispute, Ronwood asserts that as a result of its continued provision of work, no lien period has yet been set.

While we understand that Ronwood continued to perform work for Spyglass up to on or about June 14, 2016, any provision of services after that time was not performed for Spyglass, but was in fact performed for the purchaser of all of Spyglass' interests, SanLing Energy Ltd. ("**SanLing**"). Enclosed for your reference is a copy of the Sale Approval and Vesting Order, approving the sale of all of Spyglass' property to SanLing, who is the nominee of Sinopeak Energy Ltd. Further information regarding the Receivership proceedings is available on the Receiver's website at: www.ey.com/ca/spyglassresources.

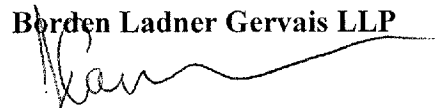
We further understand that Ronwood issued its first invoice to SanLing dated July 6, 2016. Therefore, in order to preserve any lien rights as against Spyglass that Ronwood may have had, Ronwood had until, at the very latest, October 6, 2016 to register a lien against Spyglass in accordance with the Alberta *Builders' Lien Act*.

In light of this, in our view there is no legal merit to Ronwood's Notice of Dispute. Please confirm whether Ronwood will voluntarily withdraw its Notice of Dispute on or before 4:00 pm (MST) on Friday November 4, 2016, failing which the Receiver will bring a court application to seek a declaration that Ronwood's Notice of Dispute be set-aside and the Receiver's costs of having to bring such application be paid by Ronwood on a solicitor-client basis.
