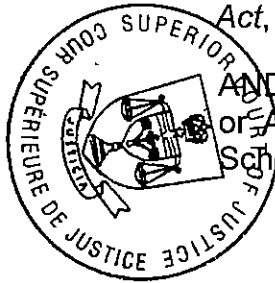

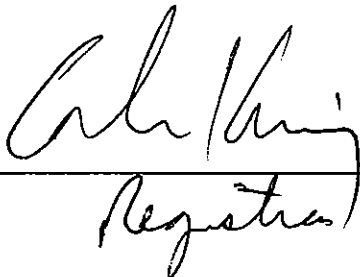
THIS MOTION made by the Applicants was heard this day at
