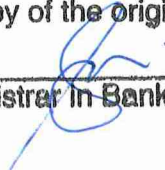

UPON THE APPLICATION of Royal Bank of Canada ("**RBC**"); AND UPON READING the Affidavit of Jessica Chohan, filed in the Court of Queen's Bench Action commenced by Royal Bank of Canada ("**RBC**") against Copperline (and others) to recover the indebtedness owed to it and enforce its security (the "**Receivership Action**") and the Application filed herein and proof of service thereof and the pleadings and proceedings had and taken herein; AND UPON HEARING from counsel for RBC and any other interested parties who may be present;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Service of notice of this application and supporting materials is hereby declared to be good and sufficient, and no other person is required to have been served with notice of this application, and time for service of this application is abridged to that actually given.
2. The thirty day period in which the proposal trustee of Copperline Excavating Ltd. ("**Copperline**") has to file a proposal pursuant to section 62.(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*, RSC 1985,c B-3 (the "**BIA**") in respect of Copperline are hereby terminated.

3. The stay of proceedings with respect to Copperline pursuant to section 69(1) of the BIA is hereby lifted with respect to RBC.
4. RBC is hereby permitted to use, reference, and rely upon the Affidavit of Jessica Chohan and the Bench Brief filed in the Receivership Action for the purpose of the hearing of this Application.
5. RBC is hereby permitted and granted leave to commence the Receivership Action *nunc pro tunc*.
6. RBC is awarded costs of this application on a solicitor and client basis.
