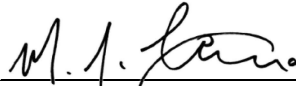

UPON THE DESK APPLICATION of Ernst & Young Inc. in its capacity as the Court-appointed Receiver (the “**Receiver**”) of the undertakings, property and assets of D.L.M. Oilfield Enterprises Ltd. (“**DLM**”) for an order varying interim distribution Order granted on September 21, 2020 (the “**Interim Distribution Order**”); **AND UPON BEING** advised by counsel for the Receiver that counsel for Laurentian Bank of Canada (“**Laurentian**”) and internal counsel for Bank of Montreal (“**BMO**”) agree that neither creditor requires from the other the settlement agreement described at paragraph 2(c) of the Interim Distribution Order (the “**Settlement Agreement**”);

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:

1. The Interim Distribution Order is varied by removing from paragraph 2(c) thereof the requirement that the Receiver receive the Settlement Agreement before making the interim distributions referred to therein and the Receiver is authorized and directed to issue the following interim distributions:
 - (a) \$56,050.00 shall be paid to BMO, as described at paragraph 8(a) of the Receiver's Third Supplement to the Third Report; and
 - (b) \$1,682.50 shall be paid to Ritchie Bros Auctioneers, as described at paragraph 8(b) of the Receiver's Third Supplement to the Third Report.
2. Service of this Order shall be deemed good and sufficient by posting a copy of this Order on the Receiver's website at: www.ey.com/ca/dlm provided, however, that the Receiver shall provide a copy of this Order to Laurentian and BMO.
