The Foreign Representative brings this motion for a brief stay extension to March 8, 2022. The motion is unopposed and is supported by the Information Officer. The extension will give stakeholders an opportunity to address the recent developments in the US (I am told that a decision has just been rendered on the Dismissal and Injunction Hearing and that the injunction has been extended). There is a return hearing in this court on March 7, 2022 with respect to the proposed
