UPON THE APPLICATION of Glenogle Energy Inc. ("GEI"), Glenogle Energy LP ("GELP") and 1651558 Alberta Ltd. (collectively, "Glenogle" or the "Applicants"); **AND UPON HAVING READ** the Fourth Report of Ernst & Young Inc., the Court-appointed Monitor (the "Monitor") of Glenogle, dated May 2, 2022 (the "Fourth Report") and the Confidential Supplement thereto, dated May 2, 2022 (the "Confidential Supplement"); **AND UPON HEARING** the submissions of counsel for Glenogle, the Monitor and other interested parties that

may be present, and no one appearing for any other person on the service list, although properly served as appears from the Affidavit of Service, filed;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:

SERVICE

1. Service of notice of this application and supporting materials is hereby declared to be good and sufficient, no other person is required to have been served with notice of this application, and time for service of this application is abridged to that actually given.

SEALING ORDER

1. The Confidential Supplement shall be sealed on the Court file, kept confidential and not form part of the public record, notwithstanding Division 4 of Part 6 of the *Alberta Rules of Court*, until the earlier of:
 - a) the Monitor filing a Monitor's Closing Certificate in the form appended to the Approval and Reverse Vesting Order granted in these proceedings by the Honourable Justice J.T. Neilson on May 12, 2022, confirming that the transaction contemplated by the April 21, 2022 Acquisition Agreement entered into between Glenogle and Astara Energy Corp. has closed; or
 - b) further order of this Honourable Court.
2. The Clerk of the Court shall file the Confidential Supplement in a sealed envelope attached to a notice that sets out the style of cause of these proceedings and states that:

- A) THE MONITOR FILING A MONITOR'S CERTIFICATE IN THE FORM APPENDED TO THE APPROVAL AND REVERSE VESTING ORDER GRANTED IN THESE PROCEEDINGS ON MAY 12, 2022, CONFIRMING THAT THE TRANSACTION CONTEMPLATED BY THE ACQUISITION AGREEMENT

DESCRIBED IN THE APPROVAL AND REVERSE VESTING
ORDER HAS CLOSED; OR

B) FURTHER ORDER OF THIS HONOURABLE COURT.

3. Leave is hereby granted to any person or party affected by this Order to apply to this Honourable Court for a further order modifying or varying the terms of paragraphs 1 and 2 of this Order, with such application to be brought on no less than seven (7) days' notice to the Receiver and any other affected party pursuant to the *Alberta Rules of Court*.
