**ORDER**  
(re: Lift Stay Motion)

**THIS MOTION**, made by Darryl Gebien (the "**Ontario Plaintiff**"), the plaintiff in the class action commenced on May 15, 2019, in the Ontario Superior Court of Justice, bearing Court File No. 00620048-00CP (the "**Ontario Action**"), was heard this day by Zoom videoconference due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

**ON READING** the Notice of Motion and the Affidavit of Caitlin Leach affirmed March 31, 2022, and the exhibits thereto, and on hearing the submissions of the counsel for the Ontario Plaintiff, the Chapter 11 Debtors and such other parties listed on the counsel slip, no one else


appearing for any other person on the service list, although properly served as evidenced by the affidavits of service filed with the Court,

**1. THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES** that the stay of proceedings provided for in the Order (Re: Related Party Stay) dated December 30, 2019 granted in this proceeding, be and is hereby lifted solely for the following purposes: (a) to permit the Ontario Plaintiff to proceed with a motion for certification as against Purdue Pharma Inc. and Purdue Frederick Inc. (the “**Purdue Canada Defendants**”); and (b) to permit the Purdue Canada Defendants to proceed with or participate in any motion to dismiss the Ontario Action, both before the Ontario Superior Court of Justice, as well as any motions, appeals or other proceedings in connection therewith. For avoidance of doubt, nothing in this Order shall affect the stays of proceeding set forth in the Initial Recognition Order (Foreign Main Proceeding) dated September 19, 2019, the Supplemental Order (Foreign Main Proceeding) dated September 19, 2019 (together, the “**Initial Recognition Orders**”) as against the Chapter 11 Debtors (as defined in the Initial Recognition Orders).

**2. THIS COURT ORDERS** that the relief to lift the stay of proceedings provided for in the Order (Re: Related Party Stay) dated December 30, 2019 as against The Purdue Frederick Company Inc. is hereby adjourned to a date scheduled at a further case conference if requested by the Ontario Plaintiff.

**3. THIS COURT ORDERS** that there shall be no costs of this motion.

**4. THIS COURT ORDERS** that this Order and all its provisions are effective from the date it is made without any need for entry and filing.
