I, **Jared Enns**, lawyer, of 2200 – 885 West Georgia Street, Vancouver, British Columbia,
SWEAR THAT:

1. I am a partner at Cassels Brock & Blackwell LLP ("**CBB**"), counsel for Ernst & Young Inc. ("**EYI**") in its capacity as the court appointed receiver (the "**Receiver**") of PE Consulting Ltd. As such, I have personal knowledge of the facts hereinafter deposed to except where stated to be on information and belief, in which case I verily believe them to be true.
2. I am one of the individuals at CBB that has had primary carriage of this proceeding.
3. Attached hereto and marked as indicated are the following Exhibits (together, the "**Invoices**" or the "**CBB Accounts**");

4. As detailed in the Invoices, from November 2, 2020 to July 31, 2022, CBB's invoiced fees amounted to \$32,976.50 and CBB incurred and invoiced for disbursements in the amount of \$229.50 and taxes in the amount of \$3,971.88 for a total of \$37,177.88. I estimate an additional \$5,000 in legal fees will be incurred through to a completion of this matter.

5. The fees set out in the Invoices are calculated on the basis of the hours spent by CBB personnel, multiplied by the applicable standard hourly rates charged by CBB. The total time comprised in the Invoices is 84.5 hours at an average hourly rate of \$390 per hour ($\$32,976.50 \div 84.5$). To the best of my knowledge, information and belief, those hourly rates are consistent with those charged by other law firms for work of a similar nature in Vancouver, B.C.

6. This matter was primarily directed by the following counsel:

- (a) **Jared Enns.** I joined CBB as an associate in May, 2017, and became a partner at CBB in 2022. I am a member of CBB's Advocacy and Restructuring and Insolvency groups. My commercial litigation practice focuses on commercial lease disputes, shareholder and transactional litigation, contractual disputes and tort claim. My insolvency practice focuses on bankruptcy proceedings, receiverships and commercial restructuring. Prior to joining Cassels, I practiced at a Winnipeg-based firm and at a large, international firm in Vancouver. I have, having appeared before the British Columbia Supreme Court, the Manitoba Court of Queen's Bench, the Manitoba Court of Appeal, the Alberta Court of Appeal, the British Columbia Court of Appeal, and have been counsel at the Supreme

Court of Canada. Attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit “L”** to this my Affidavit is a true copy of Jared’s *curriculum vitae* maintained by CBB.

- (b) **H. Lance Williams.** Prior to joining McCarthy Tétrault LLP in 2021, Lance was a member of the CBB insolvency group at the time he joined CBB as a partner in February, 2017. Prior to joining CBB, Lance was a member of the DLAP insolvency group since joining the firm as an associate in 2008. Lance became a partner of DLAP in 2014, and continued practicing in the DLAP insolvency group until joining CBB. Lance was called to the bars of Alberta and Saskatchewan in 2007, British Columbia in 2008, and Yukon in 2015. Lance practices primarily in the areas of commercial insolvency, including on numerous complex restructuring and receivership matters. Lance was listed in the 2021 publication of Best Lawyers in Canada for insolvency and restructuring. Lance is a member of the British Columbia Model Order Committee, has published several publications on complex restructuring matters and taught insolvency law at the University of British Columbia law school. Attached hereto and marked as **Exhibit “M”** to this my Affidavit is a true copy of Lance’s *curriculum vitae* maintained while he was a partner at CBB. Lance departed CBB in August 2021.

7. To the best of my knowledge, information and belief, the information contained in the Invoices as to:

- (a) the number of hours worked;
- (b) the nature of work performed;
- (c) the identity of the individuals who performed work; and
- (d) the rates charged for the work performed;

is true and correct in all respects.

8. I have reviewed the accounts of CBB and do verily believe that:

- (a) CBB’s professional fees and disbursements have been properly incurred and are fair and reasonable in the circumstances;

- (b) the work completed by CBB was delegated to the appropriate professionals in CBB with the appropriate seniority and appropriate hourly rates;
- (c) CBB's fees in this matter are consistent with the fees charged by similar firms with the capacity to handle a file of comparable size and complexity;
- (d) the Invoices were provided to the Receiver when rendered, and all have been approved by the Receiver; and
- (e) the services were performed by CBB in a prudent and economical manner.

9. I make this affidavit expressly for the purposes of the Receiver's application to approve its accounts and the CBB Accounts, and for no other purpose. In particular, nothing herein is a waiver of solicitor-client privilege by the Receiver.
