ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE CONWAY:

All defined terms used in this Endorsement shall, unless otherwise defined, have the meanings ascribed to them in the Motion Record of LTL Management LLC (in its capacity as foreign representative of its estate) dated October 21, 2022.

The Foreign Representative seeks recognition, under Part IV of the CCAA, of the Expert Appointment Order entered by the New Jersey Bankruptcy Court on August 15, 2022. The motion is unopposed and is supported by the Information Officer.

Pursuant to the Expert Appointment Order, an expert will provide a report to the New Jersey Bankruptcy Court on the volume and value of talc claims in both the United States and Canada. The order empowers the expert to solicit information from Canadian stakeholders to facilitate the estimation process. The Foreign Representative seeks recognition of the order to ensure that there is symmetry between the claimants in both countries. The motion has been widely served and as noted above, there is no opposition to it. I am satisfied that recognition of the Expert Appointment Order should be granted.

The motion also seeks approval of the activities of the Information Officer and the fees and disbursements of the Information Officer and its counsel. That relief is also unopposed. I am satisfied that the approvals should be granted.
