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ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE OSBORNE:

1. LTL, or the Debtor, in its capacity as Foreign Representative, moves for an order amending the stay period referenced in paragraph seven of my Supplemental Recognition Order dated April 13, 2023, simply to delete the reference to April 24, 2023 and replace it with May 3, 2023.
2. Defined terms have the meaning given to them in the motion materials and/or my earlier orders and endorsements in this proceeding.
3. The final form of the 2023 Preliminary Injunction Order has not been settled by the parties or entered by the New Jersey Bankruptcy Court. It is hoped that that will be achieved shortly. In the interim, the stay is effective in Canada until the later of the expiry of the 2023 TRO, by its terms, unless extended by a further order of the New Jersey Bankruptcy Court; or April 24, 2023.
4. As Ms. Parente submits, it makes good practical sense to preserve the status quo and maintain stability in Canada. The short extension sought today should give the parties sufficient if brief time to review the 2023 Preliminary Injunction Order when finalized and deliver supplementary materials if and as necessary.
5. The Foreign Representative, in consultation with the Information Officer, submits that no Canadian party will be prejudiced.
6. It is expected that the Foreign Representative will return to this Court as soon as practicable to seek a recognition of the 2023 Preliminary Injunction Order once settled.
7. The relief sought today is not opposed by any party. The Service List was served with the motion materials.
8. I agree with the submissions of Ms. Parente that the relief sought is appropriate, reasonable and proportionate in the circumstances.
9. Order to go in the form signed by me which is effective immediately and without the necessity of issuing and entering.
