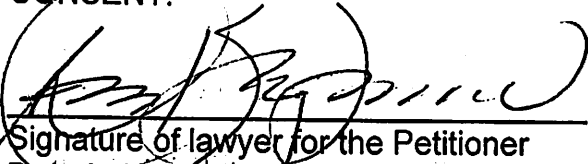

4. counsel for the insureds will provide any response material to counsel for HSBC by 10:00 pm on December 8, 2023 by email.
5. for the convenience of the parties, this order may be prepared by counsel for the petitioner and signature of this order by all counsel other than for the petitioner is hereby dispensed with. This order may be signed in counterparts and may be signed electronically.
