SUPPLEMENTAL INITIAL ORDER

THIS APPLICATION made by Terrace Bay Pulp Inc. (the "Applicant") for the relief contained in paragraph 1(g) of the Applicant's Notice of Application, including a declaration that the Directors' Charge and the Administration Charge have priority over the security interests of The Corporation of the Township of Terrace Bay (the "Township"), Computershare Trust Company of Canada (the "Trustee") and creditors who have registered construction lien claims against the Applicant's real property (the "Construction Lien Claimants", and together with the Township and the Trustee, the "Comeback Parties") was heard this day at 330 University Avenue, Toronto, Ontario.

ON READING the Notice of Application, the Affidavit of Wolfgang Gericke sworn January 24, 2012, and the Exhibits thereto, and the Initial Order of Mr. Justice Morawetz dated January 25, 2012 (the "Initial Order") and the Affidavit of Nancy Thompson sworn February 1,

2012, and on being advised that the Comeback Parties were served with the Application Record and the Initial Order in accordance with the Initial Order (as confirmed by the affidavits of service of Martina Eva Mager sworn January 26, 2012, Maria Konidis sworn January 26, 2012, Tim Lenehan sworn January 27, 2012, Wondimu Feleke sworn January 27, 2012 and Jackie Moher sworn January 27, 2012), and that none of the Comeback Parties served any materials in support of any opposition to the relief sought by January 31, 2012 as required by paragraph 39 of the Initial Order, and on hearing the submissions of counsel for the Applicant, counsel for Ernst & Young Inc. in its capacity as Monitor of the Applicant and counsel for the Trustee, the Township and the Construction Lien Claimants not opposing the relief sought, no other parties appearing:

DEFINITIONS

1. THIS COURT ORDERS that all terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meaning given to them in the Initial Order.

SERVICE

2. THIS COURT ORDERS that the time for service of the Notice of Application and the Application Record on the Comeback Parties is hereby abridged and validated, and that the Applicant has served the Comeback Parties in accordance with paragraphs 37 and 38 of the Initial Order, so that the hearing in respect of the relief sought in paragraph 1(g) of this Application is properly returnable today and hereby dispenses with further service thereof.

PRIORITY OF CHARGES

3. THIS COURT ORDERS that notwithstanding paragraph 35 of the Initial Order, the Charges have priority over the Encumbrances in favour of the Construction Lien Claimants and the Township with effect from and after the date of the Initial Order.
4. THIS COURT ORDERS that the relief sought as against the Trustee is adjourned to Tuesday February 7, 2012.
